Legislation Title: A RESOLUTION establishing joint City Council - Mayor Citywide policy priorities in support of Federal Comprehensive Immigration Reform.

Summary of the Legislation:

This is a resolution establishing policy priorities in support of Federal Comprehensive Immigration Reform – identifying nine specific policy areas that include an accessible road map to citizenship for all individuals living in the US, family reunification, and providing dignity to immigrants in employment and court.

The legislation outlines Seattle’s long history of engagement on immigration issues and acknowledges the diverse communities that live within the City.
