
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That Section 1.1 of Ordinance 90789, as last amended by Ordinance 102366, is further amended to read as follows:

Section 1.1. That in lieu of the establishment of the account and the crediting thereto of the amount provided in Section 1 of this ordinance, any such member of the City Employees' Retirement System or Health Department employee who has retained membership in the State Retirement System under Ordinance 87017, upon retirement or award of retirement allowance as the case may be, may by written request to the head of the department in which such person is employed elect to receive a cash payment of an amount equal to the amount provided in Section 1 of this ordinance. Upon receipt of such written request, the head of the department in which such person was employed is authorized to pay such amount to such person and for such purpose to use unexpended and unencumbered budget salary funds accumulating in the Budget of such department.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.






