
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there is hereby established a "Police Officer of the Year Award" account in the "General Donations and Gift Trust Fund" and the donation of Batjac Productions, Inc. to The City of Seattle in the amount of \$1000 for the purpose of establishing a perpetual Police Officer of the Year Award program together with such additional donations as may be made for such purpose, is hereby accepted, and shall be deposited in said fund and credited to said account, and the City Comptroller is authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the warrants against such amounts for expenses in connection with such award program, including the purchase of plaques honoring outstanding officers for display within the Police Department, purchase of medals and ribbons, and certificates, on vouchers approved by the Chief of Police, all as contemplated by C.F. 277432.


(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
