ORDINANCE 104623

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Fire Department; amending Section 1 of Ordinance 104346 to authorize mutual firefighting assistance agreements with certain additional cities, counties, port districts and other governmental entities.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance 104346 is amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That the Chief of the Fire Department is hereby authorized for and on behalf of The City of Seattle to execute a "Mutual Fire Fighting Assistance Agreement" substantially in the form contained in C.F. 280804, with the cities of Aberdeen, Anacortes, Bellingham, Bremerton, Edmonds, Everett, Hoquiam, Kennewick, Longview, Olympia, Pasco, Port Angeles, Port Townsend, Richland, Tacoma, Vancouver, and such other cities, towns, counties, port districts and other governmental entities authorized and expressing willingness to enter into such agreement providing for mutual aid in fighting major shipboard fires, which agreement shall be executed in such number of copies as are necessary, including one copy to be retained by the Chief of the Fire Department and one copy to be filed in the records of the City Comptroller's office.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
