ORDINANCE 106623

AN ORDINANCE amending Section 4 of Ordinance 96897 to restrict eligibility of members and former members of the Seattle Design Commission for employment in connection with City capital improvement projects.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 4 of Ordinance 96897 is amended to read as follows:

Section 4. Each member shall serve for a term of two years except that the term of office for the first members shall be staggered so that four serve for two years, ending May 31, 1970, and three serve for one year, ending May 31, 1969. A person appointed to fill a vacancy shall serve for the remainder of the unexpired term. Any member of the Commission may be appointed to succeed himself. The membership of the Commission shall not be limited to residents of the City or residents of the State of Washington.

No member of the Commission during his or her term of office and for six months thereafter, and no person, firm or corporation employing such member during such period, shall be eligible for employment by or to contract with the City in connection with any capital improvement project reviewed by the Commission during such term of office.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section...2.. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.



NO MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION DURING HIS OR HER TERM OF OFFICE AND FOR SIX MONTHS THEREAFTER, AND NO PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION EMPLOYING SUCH MEMBER DURING SUCH PERIOD, SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR EMPLOYMENT BY OR TO CONTRACT WITH THE CITY IN CONNECTION WITH ANY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT REVIEWED BY THE COMMISSION DURING SUCH TERM OF OFFICE.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
