ORDINANCE 109501

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Refrigeration Regulation Ordinance, Ordinance 84297, and amending Section 13 increasing license and examination fees for certain occupations.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. As of January 1, 1981, Section 13 of Ordinance 84297 is amended as follows:

A separate license shall be required for each separate place of business of a Refrigeration Service Shop, Refrigeration Contractor, or Air Conditioning Contractor. A valid Refrigeration Contractor's

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

license, a Refrigeration Service Shop license, or an Air Conditioning Contractor's license may be transferred to a new location upon payment of a sum equal to ten percent (10%) of the annual license fee.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. As of January 1, 1981, Section 13 of Ordinance 84297 is amended as follows:
