AN ORDINANCE amending Section 1.140 of the New Seattle License Code (Ordinance 108934) by adding a new subsection (7) making it unlawful to make false statements or misstatements of any material matter in records required to be kept by this Code, and by repealing duplicative Subsection (6).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1.140 of the New Seattle License Code (Ordinance 108934) (Seattle Municipal Code 6. \_\_\_ ) is amended as follows:

Section 1.140 -- Unlawful Acts

(1) It is unlawful for any person to engage in any activity for which a license is required without first obtaining a license in accordance with the provisions of this Code;

(2) It is unlawful for any person to employ an individual in the capacity of an agent if that agent has failed to obtain any license required by this Code;

(3) It is unlawful for any licensee or agent thereof to authorize any unlicensed person to engage in activity for which a license is required, under color of a license issued to the licensee;

(4) It is unlawful for any person to make or manufacture any license, license plate, badge, or tag required by this Code except upon order of the Director;

(5) It is unlawful for any person other than the Director, a licensee, or agent thereof to possess any license, identification card, license plate, badge, or tag issued pursuant to this Code;

~~((6) It is unlawful for any person to knowingly make or cause or authorize to be made any false statement in any~~

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1.140 of the New Seattle License Code (Ordinance 108934) *(Seattle Municipal Code 6. — )* is amended as follows:

Section 1.140 -- Unlawful Acts

(1) It is unlawful for any person to engage in any activity for which a license is required without first obtaining a license in accordance with the provisions of this Code;

(2) It is unlawful for any person to employ an individual in the capacity of an agent if that agent has failed to obtain any license required by this Code;

(3) It is unlawful for any licensee or agent thereof to authorize any unlicensed person to engage in activity for which a license is required, under color of a license issued to the licensee;

(4) It is unlawful for any person to make or manufacture any license, license plate, badge, or tag required by this Code except upon order of the Director;

(5) It is unlawful for any person other than the Director, a licensee, or agent thereof to possess any license, identification card, license plate, badge, or tag issued pursuant to this Code;


