ORDINANCE 109883

AN ORDINANCE correcting errors in Section 2 of Ordinance 109648, to repeal only certain sections of Ordinances 88789, 100478, 102636, 106063, and 107157, which add to or amend Chapter 6.22 of the Seattle Municipal Code.

WHEREAS, the intent of Ordinance 109648 was to repeal only those ordinances or parts of ordinances adding or amending Sections 103, 104, 105, and 107 through 114 of Ordinance 48022, the License Code (Chapter 6.22 of the Seattle Municipal Code); and

WHEREAS, Ordinances 88789, 100478, 102636, 106063, and 107157 amended many sections of the License Code in addition to sections in Chapter 6.22; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 88789, 100478, 102636, 106063, and 107157 were repealed in totality in error by Ordinance 109648; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 109648 inadvertently repealed Ordinances 78349, 79402 and 83281; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. As of its effective date, Section 2 of Ordinance 109648 is amended as follows:

Section 2. Chapter 6.22 of the Seattle Municipal Code, and Sections 103, 104, 105, and 107 through 114 of the License Code (Ordinance 48022), and ordinance adding to or amending such sections, namely ((as added or amended by)) Ordinances 53281, 60694, 66558, 72318, 73763, 74223, 75087, ((78349, 79402)) 79606, 80689, 80738, ((83281, 88789)) 89770, 95008, 97841, 100014, 104649, 106189, and Section 4 of Ordinance 100478, and Sections 48, 49, 50, 51, 52, 53, and 54 of Ordinance 102636, and Section 4 of Ordinance 106063, and Sections 18 and 19 of Ordinance 107157, and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 2. Any act pursuant to the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.


