ORDINANCE 110894

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Seattle Arts Commission Operating Fund; closing and eliminating such Fund, transferring the remaining assets and liabilities to the General Fund, and repealing Section 6 of Ordinance 99982 and SMC 3.56.050.

WHEREAS, the City created the Seattle Arts Commission Operating Fund for the purposes of paying all Seattle Arts Commission expenses incurred in the performance of its duties and responsibilities, and

WHEREAS, the Seattle Arts Commission Operating Fund is almost entirely supported by contributions from the General Fund, making it unnecessary to maintain a separate operating fund;

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City to close the Seattle Arts Commission Operating Fund and transfer the remaining cash balance to the General Fund; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Seattle Arts Commission Operating Fund is hereby closed and eliminated effective December 31, 1982.

Section 2: All assets and liabilities remaining in the Seattle Arts Commission Operating Fund as of December 31, 1982, are transferred to the General Fund; and the City Comptroller is hereby authorized and directed to make such transfers.

Section 3: As of December 31, 1982, SMC 3.56.050 and Section 6 of Ordinance 99982 are hereby repealed.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 4.... This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
