AN ORDINANCE relating to floating home moorages, amending Ordinance No. 111309 by adding a new Section (4) to exempt certain evictions from the floating home eviction moratorium.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance 111309 is amended by adding thereto a new Section 4 to read as follows:

Section 4. The eviction prohibitions contained in this Ordinance shall not apply to the eviction or attempted eviction of a floating home for any of the reasons set forth in Subsections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Section 3 of Ordinance No. 109280 (Section 7.20.030(A) (B) (C) and (D) of the Seattle Municipal Code).

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 2..... This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance 111300 is amended by adding thereto a new Section 4 to read as follows:

Section 4. The eviction prohibitions contained in this Ordinance shall not apply to the eviction or attempted eviction of a floating home for any of the reasons set forth in Subsections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Section 3 of Ordinance No. 109280 (Section 7.30.030(A) (B) (C) and (D) of the Seattle Municipal Code).

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.


