ORDINANCE **111441**

AN ORDINANCE repealing Seattle Municipal Code Chapters 6.06, 6.26, 6.34, 6.52, and 6.210 (Ordinance 48022, Sections 331-331.8; Sections 267-270; Sections 302-305; and Sections 206-209; and a portion of Ordinance 108934, respectively) to end the licensing and regulation of bail bondsmen; going out of business or closing out sales; locksmiths; side sewer contractors; and for-hire vehicles other than taxicabs.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Seattle Municipal Code Chapter 6.06, entitled Bail Bondsmen, and each of its sections, 6.06.010 through 6.06.090, (Ordinance 48022, Sections 331-331.8 inclusive, as amended by Ordinances 89048, 92871, 100478, 102636, 106063 and 110888) are each repealed.

Section 2. Seattle Municipal Code Chapter 6.26, entitled Going Out of Business or Closing-out Sales, and each of its sections, 6.26.010-6.26.070 (Ordinance 48022, Sections 267 through 270-1 inclusive, as amended by Ordinances 61818, 88789, 92507, 100545, 102205, and 102636) are each repealed.

Section 3. Seattle Municipal Code Chapter 6.34, entitled Locksmiths, and each of its sections, 6.34.010 through 6.34.060 (Ordinance 48022, Sections\*206-209, as amended by Ordinances 65313, 75088, 88837, 88789, 102636, 10715, and Ordinance 110888) are repealed.

Section 4. Seattle Municipal Code 6.52, entitled Side Sewer Contractors, and each of its sections, 6.52.010 through 6.52.050 (Ordinance 48022, Sections 206-209 inclusive, as amended by Ordinances 4994, 78246, 76248, 88789, 89733, 91281, 102636, 107157, and 110888) are repealed.

Section 5. Seattle Municipal Code Chapter 6.210, entitled For-Hire Vehicles, and each of its sections, 6.210.010 through 6.210.110 (Ordinance 108934, Sections 5.020, 5.024, 5.030, 5.035, 5.072, 5.140, 5.170, 5.200, and 5.210-230, as amended by Ordinance 109348) are repealed.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect January 1, 1984.

AN ORDINANCE repealing Seattle Municipal Code Chapters 6.06, 6.26, 6.36, 6.52, and 6.210 (Ordinance 88677, Sections 531-531.3; Sections 267-270; Sections 307-323; and Sections 206-209; and a portion of Ordinance 108934, respectively) to end the licensing and regulation of bail bondsmen; going out of business or closing out sales; locksmiths; side sewer contractors; and for-hire vehicles other than taxicabs.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Seattle Municipal Code Chapter 6.06, entitled Bail Bondsmen, and each of its sections, 6.06.010 through 6.06.090, (Ordinance 48022, Sections 331-331.8 inclusive, as amended by Ordinances 89048, 92871, 100473, 102636, 106063 and 110888) are each repealed.

Section 2. Seattle Municipal Code Chapter 6.26, entitled Going Out of Business or Closing-out Sales, and each of its sections, 6.26.010-6.26.070 (Ordinance 48022, Sections 267 through 270-1 inclusive, as amended by Ordinances 61814, 88789, 92507, 100545, 102205, and 102636) are each repealed.

Section 3. Seattle Municipal Code Chapter 6.36, entitled Locksmiths, and each of its sections, 6.36.010 through 6.36.060 (Ordinance 48022, Sections 206-209, as amended by Ordinances 63313, 75088, 88837, 88789, 102636, 10715, and Ordinance 110888) are repealed.

Section 4. Seattle Municipal Code 6.52, entitled Side Sewer Contractors, and each of its sections, 6.52.010 through 6.52.030 (Ordinance 48022, Sections 206-209 inclusive, as amended by Ordinances 4974, 78246, 78248, 88789, 89733, 91281, 102636, 107157, and 110888) are repealed.

Section 5. Seattle Municipal Code Chapter 6.210, entitled For-Hire Vehicles, and each of its sections, 6.210.010 through 6.210.110 (Ordinance 108934, Sections 5.020, 5.024, 5.030, 5.035, 5.072, 5.140, 5.170, 5.200, and 5.210-230, as amended by Ordinance 109348) are repealed.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect January 1, 1984.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
