1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the Department of Parks and Recreation,
2 making reimbursable appropriations from the Cumulative Reserve
3 Fund, Main Fund, and the General Donations and Gift Trust Fund,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY AS FOLLOWS:

6 Section 1. As requested by the Superintendent of Parks and
7 Recreation and recommended by the Mayor in attachments hereto, in
8 addition to the appropriations authorized by Ordinances 111805,
9 112288, and 112597, the sum of Four Hundred Fifty-One Thousand, Five
10 Hundred Dollars (\$451,500) or so much thereof as may be necessary is
11 hereby appropriated from the Cumulative Reserve Fund, Main Fund and
12 the sum of Four Hundred Fifty-One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars
13 (\$451,500) or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby
14 appropriated from the General Donations and Gift Trust Fund, Elephant
15 Exhibit Account, for the design and partial construction of the Asian
16 Elephant Exhibit (CIP Project #07-0640). The City Comptroller is
17 authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary
18 warrants.

19 Section 2. The appropriation from the Cumulative Reserve Fund
20 made in Section 1 hereof is to be fully reimbursed from the proceeds
21 of the sale of general obligation bonds pursuant to King County
22 Ordinance 7547 which was approved by the qualified electors of King
23 County at the special election on November 5, 1985.

24 Section 3. The appropriation from the General Donations and Gift
25 Trust Fund made in Section 1 hereof is to be fully reimbursed from the
26 Seattle Zoological Society and others pursuant to Section 1 of
27 Ordinance 112805.

28 Section 4. Any act pursuant to the authority and prior to the
effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Subject: Zoo Asian Elephant Exhibit

We request adoption of the attached legislation making an appropriation of \$903,000 for complete design and partial construction of the next phase of the Asian Elephant Exhibit at the Woodland Park Zoological Gardens. As you know, the Seattle Post-Intelligencer and many other firms, organizations, and individuals have been actively working on the "Save Our Elephants" (SOE) fund raising campaign. To date there is over \$2 million in donations or pledges from private contributors. All donations are placed on deposit in the bank account of the Seattle Zoological Society.

The Zoo Commission and the Save Our Elephants Committee have recommended that \$3.3 million in donations be raised over the next three years and that the City and other public funding provide an equal amount to complete the entire exhibit estimated at \$6.7 million. King County has appropriated \$60,000 to assist with construction costs.

The concept planning and schematic design of the Asian Elephant Exhibit has been completed by the architectural firm of Jones & Jones. Construction is expected to be phased over a two-year period with initial site preparation to start in March 1986. The requested \$903,000 will allow for completion of design and related costs and the next stage construction consisting of primary site utilities for the entire project. These utilities include water, communications, power, storm and sanitary sewers, and related work.


