BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. As of January 1, 1987, Subsection A of Section 21.76.040 of the Seattle Municipal Code (Section 4 of Ordinance 104472, as last amended by Ordinance 112549) is further amended as follows:

A. Sewer:


Those residing in dwellings subject to single-family rates	(\$3.28)	<u>\$3.85</u>
Those residing in dwellings subject to duplex and multi- family rates.	(\$1.86)	<u>\$2.25</u>

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

Section 1. As of January 1, 1987, Subsection A of Section 21.76.040 of the Seattle Municipal Code (Section 4 of Ordinance 104472, as last amended by Ordinance 112549) is further amended as follows:

A. Sewer:

Those residing in dwellings
