ORDINANCE 114889

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AN ORDINANCE relating to the Solid Waste Utility; amending Chapter 21.36 of the Seattle Municipal Code to correct an administrative error contained in Ordinance 114723.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Effective October 4, 1989, the heading of Section 21.36.022 of the Seattle Municipal Code (Ordinance 113502, Section 3, as last amended by Ordinance 114723) is amended as follows:

21.36.022 Business Conducted on ((Private)) Public
Property--Use of City Receptacles prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for anyone conducting business on public property to deposit any solid waste accumulated in the course of such business in any receptacle on public property which has been provided by the City for refuse disposal unless that receptacle has been designated for such business use.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section...2... This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
