

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 2. Any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.



SUBJECT: 1991 Drainage Permit Fees

Dear Council President Kraabel:

REQUEST. We request City Council adoption of the enclosed ordinance to increase certain drainage permit fees.

BACKGROUND. DWU was directed by City Council in Resolution 28179 (the 1991 DWU Rate Policies) to prepare a status report on the costs of issuing permits and the revenues generated by permit fees. In preparing this report as part of its rate study, DWU determined that drainage permit fees were not recovering the full cost of issuing permits and that general ratepayers were subsidizing this service. In the past, the fees have not included the direct labor costs of the Operation's divisions plan review section (which reviews drainage control plans) or overhead costs associated with staff time (fringe benefits, paid absences, rent, telephones, etc.) DWU has proposed that drainage permit fees be increased to include these costs rather than asking ratepayers to continue subsidizing them.

The attached ordinance increases drainage permit fees 129 percent over 1990 levels.

IMPORTANCE. This ordinance will provide authority to raise permit fees as of January 1, 1991 to reflect more fully the cost of issuing permits.

AN ORDINANCE relating to side sewer or drain connections, amending Section 21.24.020 of the Seattle Municipal Code to increase certain permit fees.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Effective January 1, 1991, Section 21.24.020 of the Seattle Municipal Code (Section 2 of Ordinance 82583, as last amended by Ordinance 114781) is further amended as follows:

The permit application for a sewer or drain connection, repair, alteration or addition shall be made by the owner of such property or premises or by registered side sewer contractor representing the owner, and the Director of Engineering shall determine whether the permit application conforms to the requirements of this chapter and other ordinances of the City regulating side sewers and compute the amount of the fee in accordance with the following schedule:
