5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

6 Section 1. As of January 1, 1991, SMC 20.48.070 (Ordinance 114825,
7 Section 1) is amended as follows:

8 20.48.070 DAILY ADMINISTRATIVE CHARGES.

9 There is hereby imposed a charge of (~~Seventeen Dollars and fifty cents~~
10 ~~(\$17.50)) Twenty Dollars and seventy-five cents (\$20.75) per regularly
11 scheduled City employee working day from the date of notice to proceed to
12 date of acceptance of the project as to each and every public works
13 contract administered by the Board of Public Works with the exception of
14 contracts for consulting services, other service contracts, and supplemen-
15 tal public works contracts; provided that the Board of Public Works may,
16 for just cause, upon petition by a department, reduce the charges imposed
17 from the date of completion of the project to date of acceptance of the
18 project. Such charge shall be computed by the Executive Director of the
19 Board of Public Works and billed to the department or fund for which such
20 contract is administered, and receipts therefrom shall be deposited in the
21 General Fund.

NARRATIVE EXPLANATION OF ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY

Survey data was collected from each Board department and the Seattle Center regarding the estimated number of contract working days for each public works project under construction in 1991. The total of 12,471 working days for 1991 was then adjusted by 46% based on 1989 historical data of actual days charged versus estimated days by departments, for a total estimated number of 18,207 chargeable working days. In 1991, the Department proposes to charge a rate of \$20.75 per day. The rate was calculated based on the total BPW proposed budget of \$365,264 plus \$12,007 for the Cost Allocation Study, divided by the estimated number of chargeable working days in 1991, for a rate of \$20.72, rounded up to \$20.75 per day.

The \$20.75 per day rate represents an increase of \$3.25 per day over the 1990 rate of \$17.50. The \$20.75 per day rate will recover for the General Fund the expenses of the Board of Public Works Department for 1991.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Board of Public Works; amending SMC 20.40.070 to increase contract administration charges of the Board of Public Works as of January 1, 1991.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. As of January 1, 1991, SMC 20.48.070 (Ordinance 114825, Section 1) is amended as follows:

20.48.070 DAILY ADMINISTRATIVE CHARGES.

There is hereby imposed a charge of ~~((Seventeen Dollars and fifty cents (\$17.50)))~~ Twenty Dollars and seventy-five cents (\$20.75) per regularly scheduled City employee working day from the date of notice to proceed to date of acceptance of the project as to each and every public works contract administered by the Board of Public Works with the exception of contracts for consulting services, other service contracts, and supplemental public works contracts; provided that the Board of Public Works may, for just cause, upon petition by a department, reduce the charges imposed from the date of completion of the project to date of acceptance of the project. Such charge shall be computed by the Executive Director of the Board of Public Works and billed to the department or fund for which such contract is administered, and receipts therefrom shall be deposited in the General Fund.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
