

ORDINANCE 115938

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Animal Fee Ordinance; amending Seattle Municipal Code (SMC) Sections 9.26.050 and 9.26.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 9.26.050 of the Seattle Municipal Code is amended as follows:

Section 9.26.050 Other animal control fees and charges.

Other animal control fees shall be:

- A. Administrative fee for each detained animal . . . . . \$((~~20-00~~)) 35.00
- B. For each twenty-four (24) hour period or part thereof for kenneling . . . . . \$((~~-5-00~~)) 7.00
- C. For each animal adopted . . . . . \$ 5.00
- D. For each dangerous animal . . . . . \$25.00
- E. For collecting and disposing of an owner's animal whether the animal is dead or alive; or when an owner's animal is brought to the shelter for euthanasia . . . \$((~~-5-00~~)) 10.00
- F. For the handling of animals, other than dogs and cats, charges may be assessed to recover the cost of special equipment.

Section 2. Section 9.26.060 of the Seattle Municipal Code is amended as follows:

Section 9.26.060. The fees for spaying and neutering at the Municipal Spay and Neuter Clinic shall be:

Cats

- Spaying . . . . . \$((~~20-00~~)) 25.00
- Neutering . . . . . \$((~~15-00~~)) 20.00

Dogs

- Spaying . . . . . \$((~~25-00~~)) 30.00
- Neutering . . . . . \$((~~20-00~~)) 25.00
