5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

6 Section 1. Seattle Municipal Code Section 12.36.030  
7 (Ordinance 96003, Section 3, as last amended by Ordinance  
8 113502, Section 4) is further amended as follows:

9 21.36.030 Unlawful hauling of garbage -- Exceptions.

10 It is unlawful for anyone, except the following, to haul  
11 garbage through the streets in the City:

12 A. The University of Washington or its contractor;

13 B. Military establishments or their contractors;

14 C. The City's garbage contractors;

15 D. Anyone authorized to collect garbage in the City under  
16 Chapter 295, Laws of Washington 1961;

17 E. Business concerns, as to garbage originating within  
18 their own establishments;

19 F. The Seattle Housing Authority as to garbage  
20 originating on property it owns or leases;

21 provided, however, that the exempted persons and organizations  
22 may be required to deposit such garbage together with any  
23 rubbish hauled by them at refuse disposal, processing, or  
24 recovery sites provided and/or designated by the Director of  
Engineering pursuant to Section 211.36.110.

Section 2. The Director of Engineering may authorize the  
Seattle Housing Authority to haul garbage on City streets  
pursuant to Section 21.36.030 F prior to the effective date of

This Bill authorizes the Seattle Housing Authority to haul garbage from its properties through the City streets.


Fiscal Impact

**REQUEST**

We request City Council adoption of the attached ordinance. The ordinance amends Seattle Municipal Code Section 21.36.030 to authorize the Seattle Housing Authority to haul garbage from its properties through the City streets.

**BACKGROUND**

The Seattle Housing Authority wishes to collect residential solid waste from Housing Authority properties located throughout the City and haul it through City streets to compactors located at the Holly Park and Rainier Vista Garden Communities. One of our residential refuse contractors, U.S. Disposal will haul the refuse from the compactors to the South Transfer Station. The Housing Authority will save from \$250,000 to \$350,000 per year in refuse collection charges from this change. The projected revenue loss to the Solid Waste Utility has been accommodated in the new Solid Waste Utility rates.

**ORDINANCE 116220**  
 AN ORDINANCE amending Seattle Municipal Code Section 21.36.030 to authorize the Seattle Housing Authority to haul garbage from its properties through City streets.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Seattle Municipal Code Section 12.36.030 (Ordinance 96001, Section 3, as last amended by Ordinance 113532, Section 4) is further amended as follows:

21.36.030 Unlawful hauling of garbage—Exceptions.

It is unlawful for anyone, except the following, to haul garbage through the streets in the City:

- A. The University of Washington or its contractor;
- B. Military establishments or their contractors;
- C. The City's garbage contractors;
- D. Anyone authorized to collect garbage in the City under Chapter 295, Laws of Washington 1991;
- E. Business concerns, as to garbage originating within their own establishments;
- F. THE SEATTLE HOUSING AUTHORITY AS TO GARBAGE ORIGINATING ON PROPERTY IT OWNS OR LEASES,

provided, however, that the exempted persons and organizations may be required to deposit such garbage together with any rubbish hauled by them at refuse disposal, processing, or recovery sites provided and/or designated by the Director of Engineering pursuant to Section 21.36.110.

Section 2. The Director of Engineering may authorize the Seattle Housing Authority to haul garbage on City streets pursuant to Section 21.36.030 F prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the City Charter.
