

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ORDINANCE 118065

AN ORDINANCE relating to the fee schedule for street and sidewalk use permits authorized by Ordinance 116439 and amended by Ordinance 116813, by amending the Street Use Fee Schedule.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Street Use Permit Fee Schedule attached to Ordinance 116439 and made a part thereof is hereby revised to clarify the description of category 54 and to add a new category 54A to provide a fee for miscellaneous temporary uses not covered in other categories, in accordance with the following:

TYPE OF USE	PERMIT FEE	REQUIREMENTS
54. Miscellaneous uses that are for the use of the public, e.g. a street park, or plantings in a traffic circle per SMC15.04.100 (for purposes of record keeping and permission granted as authorized by the Director of Engineering)	No Fee	
54A. Miscellaneous for private temporary use of sidewalk for purposes not covered in other categories	\$20.00 for each period of up to 4 hours	Plus cost of field investigation and inspection time in excess of one hour.

Deposits are collected: 1) when a field investigation is necessary to review the application or 2) when permit compliance/inspection is expected to require more than one hour of staff time.

Section 2. The Street Use Permit Fee Schedule attached to Ordinance 116439 and made a part thereof is hereby revised to remove the distinction between patriotic flags and other flags extending over public property, by deleting line 6A of the Schedule, as follows:

TYPE OF USE	PERMIT FEE	REQUIREMENTS
6. Signs, flags, company graphics, etc. extending over public property	\$60 / year	
((6A Flags for Patriotic Display	No-Charge))	

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Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10) days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.
