AN ORDINANCE relating to pets, establishing civil penalties for violations of animal leash laws and adding new Section 18.12.085 to the Seattle Municipal Code.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is added to the Seattle Municipal Code Chapter 18.12 a new Section 18.12.085 as follows:

18.12.085 Violation - Civil penalties.

A. Violation of Section 18.12.080 shall be a civil infraction as contemplated by RCW 7.80.120 subject to the following penalties:

Initial Infraction. Imposition of a monetary penalty of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00);

Second Infraction. Imposition of a monetary penalty of One hundred Dollars (\$100.00);

Third Infraction. Imposition of a monetary penalty of One hundred twenty-five Dollars (\$125.00);

Subsequent Infractions. Imposition of a monetary penalty of One hundred fifty Dollars (\$150.00) for each infraction.

Initial infraction. Imposition of a monetary penalty of fifty dollars (\$50.00).

Second infraction. Imposition of a monetary penalty of one hundred dollars (\$100.00).

Third infraction. Imposition of a monetary penalty of one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125.00).

Subsequent infractions. Imposition of a monetary penalty of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) for each infraction.

B. If the court determines that a person has insufficient funds to pay the monetary penalty, the court may order performance of a number of hours of community service as contemplated by RCW 7.49.130(2).

C. The Seattle Municipal Court may waive the first civil penalty incurred if the violation is the first violation of Section 18.12.085 incurred by the park user on or after the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10) days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04.010.
