ORDINANCE NO. 118117

AN ORDINANCE appropriating money to pay certain audited claims and ordering the payment thereof.

Be it ordained by the City of Seattle as follows:

SECTION 1. Payment of the sum of Eighteen Million Forty Four Thousand One Hundred Twenty Six and 00/100 (\$18,044,126.00) dollars on SFMS Warrant Issue mechanical warrants numbered ~~40686595- 40689284~~ plus manual or cancellation issues for claims against the City which were audited by the Auditing Committee and reported by said committee to the City Council on April 25, 1996 consistent with appropriations heretofore made for such purpose from the appropriate Funds, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2 . Payment of the sum of Fourteen Million Seven Hundred Twenty Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty Nine and 90/100 (\$14,728,899.90) dollars on City General Salary Fund mechanical warrants numbered ~~50030751 50033921~~ plus manual and agency issues representing Gross Payroll for payroll ending date April 16, 1996 as detailed in the Payroll Summary Report for claims against the City which were audited by the Auditing Committee and reported by said committee to the City Council on April 25, 1996 consistent with appropriations heretofore made for such purpose from the appropriate Funds, is hereby approved.

SECTION 3. That any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance, being an ordinance required for the payment of salaries or current expenses, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the City Charter.
