

1 AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute  
2 agreements with the Washington State Department of Transportation for  
3 federal Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA) funds and  
4 with the Port of Seattle for the North Duwamish Intermodal Access Study;  
5 authorizing the acceptance and deposit of funds to be received; making  
6 partially reimbursable appropriations from the Transportation and Emergency  
7 Funds and increasing the expenditure allowance in the 1996 Budget of the  
8 Engineering Department; all by three fourths vote of the City Council.

9 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

10 Section 1. The Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to execute  
11 agreements with the Washington State Department of Transportation for federal  
12 Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA) grant funds in the amount  
13 of One Million, Seven Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$1,730,000) and with the  
14 Port of Seattle for One Hundred Five Thousand Dollars (\$105,000) for the North  
15 Duwamish Intermodal Study. The grant funds, when received, are hereby accepted  
16 and shall be deposited into the Transportation Fund.

17 Section 3. The expenditure allowance in the Program Category below in the  
18 1996 Budget of the Transportation Division of the Engineering Department is  
19 increased as follows:

<u>Program Category</u>	<u>Object of Expenditure</u>	<u>Amount</u>
20 ETO Transportation 21 Division	CO Capital Outlay	\$1,940,000

22 and the sum of One Million Nine Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$1,940,000) is  
23 hereby appropriated from the Transportation Fund. The Transportation Fund shall be  
24 reimbursed from funds received from the Washington State Department of  
25 Transportation, the Port of Seattle and the Emergency Fund. The sum of One  
26 Hundred Five Thousand Dollars (\$105,000) is hereby appropriated from the  
27 Emergency Fund for the partial reimbursement of the Transportation Fund for the  
28 purposes of matching federal grant funds for the North Duwamish Intermodal Study.

NOTICE: IF THE DOCUMENT IN THIS FRAME IS LESS CLEAR THAN THIS NOTICE  
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Section 4. The foregoing appropriations are made to meet actual necessary expenditures of the City for which insufficient appropriation has been made due to causes which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of the adoption of the 1996 budget, in accordance with RCW 35.32A.060.

Section 5. Any acts made consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved by the Mayor within ten (10) days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.

Dear Mayor Rice:

**REQUEST:** We request City Council passage of the attached ordinance authorizing agreements with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) for federal Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA) funds, and with the Port of Seattle for partial grant match funds for the North Duwamish Intermodal Access Project, increasing the expenditure allowance in the 1996 Engineering Budget - Transportation Capital Improvement Program and making appropriations from the Transportation and Emergency Funds.

**BACKGROUND:** The Seattle Engineering Department has been working with the Port of Seattle, King County, the Washington State Department of Transportation and private industry to develop strategies to improve access to the North Duwamish Industrial area. In 1996, SED and the Port of Seattle were awarded ISTEA funding of \$1,730,000 to evaluate intermodal access needs in this corridor. Expenditures of the ISTEA funds are currently shown for 1997 in the adopted 1996-2001 Capital Improvement Program; but the local matching funds of \$210,000 were not identified. The Port of Seattle has agreed to provide 50% of the grant match if the study begins in 1996. The Seattle Engineering Department is requesting the remaining 50% from the Emergency Fund.

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
