WHEREAS, Ordinance 117391, adopted November 28, 1994 authorized drainage rates effective for 1995 and 1996, amending Ordinance 114155; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to set biennial rates for drainage and wastewater; and

WHEREAS, the drainage rate has not been increased since 1995 and will require an increase to cover additional debt service, depreciation and other expenses; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 117391 provides for the wastewater rate increase up to \$4.23 per hundred cubic feet to cover the King County's treatment cost for 1996; and

WHEREAS, Office of Management and Planning memo to the City Council dated August 11, 1995 authorizes a rate of \$4.05 per hundred cubic feet (CCF) to solely reflect the direct passthrough of increased treatment costs as adopted by King County on June 26, 1995; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 118176, adopted June 26, 1996, established the 1996 rate of \$4.05 per hundred cubic feet; and

WHEREAS, King County passed Ordinance 12353 on June 24, 1996, to maintain the sewage treatment rate it charges to the City of Seattle at \$19.10 per residential customer equivalent (RCE) through December 31, 1998; and

WHEREAS, King County treatment costs represent 65% of the Drainage and Wastewater Utility's operating budget; and

WHEREAS, through abrogation of three FTEs in wastewater services, interest expense savings due to refunding the 1990 Drainage and Wastewater Utility Revenue Bonds, and favorable interest rates on the 1995 Drainage and Wastewater Utility Improvement Revenue Bonds, the City is able to absorb additional debt service, depreciation and other expenses to maintain its share of the 1996 wastewater rate through 1998; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Effective January 1, 1997, Subsections D and F of Seattle Municipal Code Section 21.33.030 (Ordinance 114155 as last amended by Ordinance 117391) are further amended as follows:

D. The rate categories and the corresponding annual drainage service charges are as follows:

Single-family Residential ((~~\$38.95~~)) \$41.40 per parcel

Open Space (0 - 2%) ... ((~~\$0.26~~)) \$53.43 per acre

All Other Properties Classification:

1. ....(0 - 15%) ((~~\$85.68~~)) \$91.08 per acre

2. ....(16 - 35%) ((~~144.73~~)) \$153.85 per acre

3. ....(36 - 65%) ((~~262.84~~)) \$279.40 per acre

4. ....(66 - 85%) ((~~341.58~~)) \$363.10 per acre

5. ....(86 - 100%) ((~~420.34~~)) \$446.79 per acre

F. These rates shall take effect as of January 1, ~~((1995-))~~ 1997.

Section 2. Section B of Seattle Municipal Code Section 21.28.040 (Ordinance 84390, as last amended by Ordinance 118176) is further amended as follows:

B. There is hereby imposed upon all premises served by the Drainage and Wastewater Utility and on which water is consumed, a City wastewater volume rate per CCF of metered flow per month. The minimum monthly wastewater volume charge shall be equal to the wastewater volume rate for one CCF regardless of actual metered flow. Effective January 1, 1996, the 1995 wastewater volume rate shall be increased only in the amount necessary to pass-through the cost to the Drainage and Wastewater Utility of the increase, if any, in the King County wastewater treatment rate for 1996; provided that such King County increase shall not increase the Drainage and Wastewater Utility's wastewater volume rate to more than Four Dollars and Twenty-three Cents (\$4.23) per CCF, and the actual rate has been determined by the Drainage and Wastewater Utility to be Four Dollars and Five Cents (\$4.05) per CCF through December 31, 1998.

Section 3. Any act consistent with authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10) days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04.020

- 5. . . . . (86 - 100%) (( \$420.31 )) \$446.79 per acre

F. These rates shall take effect as of January 1, ((1995.)) 1997

1. (40 - 1334) ((8-88-68)) \$21.08 per acre

2. (16 - 3555) ((144-72)) \$153.85 per acre

3. (76 - 6355) ((262-84)) \$229.30 per acre

4. (68 - 8574) ((241-58)) \$163.10 per acre

5. (86 - 10054) ((420-41)) \$446.29 per acre

F. These rates shall take effect as of January 1, (1996,) 1997.

Section 2. Subsection H of Seattle Municipal Code Section 21.28.040 (Ordinance 84390, as last amended by Ordinance 118176) is further amended as follows:

H. There is hereby imposed upon all premises served by the Drainage and Wastewater Utility and on which water is consumed, a City wastewater volume rate per CCF of metered flow per month. The minimum monthly wastewater volume charge shall be equal to the wastewater volume rate for one CCF regardless of actual metered flow. Effective January 1, 1996, the 1995 wastewater volume rate shall be increased only in the amount necessary to pass-through the cost to the Drainage and Wastewater Utility of the increase, if any, in the King County wastewater treatment rate for 1996; provided that such King County increase shall not increase the Drainage and Wastewater Utility's wastewater volume rate to more than Four Dollars and Twenty-three Cents (\$4.23) per CCF, and the actual rate has been determined by the Drainage and Wastewater Utility to be Four Dollars and Five Cents (\$4.05) per CCF through December 31, 1998.

Section 3. Any act consistent with authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.
