AN ORDINANCE amending Subsection A of Seattle Municipal Code Section 4.13.010, *Exemptions from the Civil Service and Public Safety Civil Service Systems*, to add new exempt titles for exempt positions in the Accountability Pay for Executives Program and the Managers and Strategic Advisors Compensation Programs, all by a two-thirds majority vote of the City Council.

WHEREAS one criterion for position inclusion in the Accountability Pay for Executives Program, adopted at Seattle Municipal Code 4.20.380, is exclusion from the civil service system; Now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subsection A of Seattle Municipal Code Section 4.13.010, **Exemptions from the Civil Service and Public Safety Civil Service Systems**, (Ordinance 113579 as amended), is further amended as follows:

SUBJECT: Proposed Legislation To Amend SMC Chapter 4.13

The attached council bill proposes to amend SMC Chapter 4.13, *Exemptions from the Civil Service and Public Safety Civil Service Systems*, by the inclusion of a general exemption for all positions assigned to the APEX (Accountability Pay for Executives) Program, and by exemption of new titles for exempt Managers and Strategic Advisors. The positions affected by these changes are already assigned to titles that are exempt from the civil service. This legislation will have no impact on the position incumbents.
