5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

6 Section 1. Subsection 6.288.020(B) of the Seattle Municipal Code and Ordinance 109818, §1  
7 (part), as amended, is further amended as follows:

8 **6.288.030 License required – Exceptions.**

9 B. The provisions do not apply and a license is not required:

10 \*\*\*

11 11. To engage in business as a used vessel dealer, if holding a valid Washington State  
12 Registration issued pursuant to Chapter 88.02 RCW, provided that the used vessel dealer does not sell  
13 used vessel parts.

14 Section 2. A used vessel dealer who possessed a valid Washington State Registration issued  
15 pursuant to Chapter 88.02 RCW on or after January 1, 1998, may apply in writing for a refund of any  
16 used goods dealer license fee paid after January 1, 1998. The application for a refund must be received  
17 by the Director, Revenue and Consumer Affairs, no later than December 31, 1999, and must include a  
18 copy of the valid registration.

19 Section 3. The City Clerk is directed to publish this ordinance in the City's legal newspaper, state

Subject: Exemption for Used Boat Dealers from the Used Goods License.

The attached proposed ordinance provides an exemption from the regulatory used goods license requirement for used boat dealers. Currently, the used goods license record keeping provisions contained in Seattle Municipal Code (SMC) 6.288.070 duplicate the State of Washington's record keeping requirements contained in the Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 88.02.210. Both the SMC and the RCW include procedures to track used goods in order to ensure that stolen items can be traced, and thereby improving the chances that stolen goods and the perpetrator can be found.

In an effort to reduce redundant business regulations, the Revenue and Consumer Affairs Section of the Executive Services Department proposes to eliminate the used goods license requirement contained in SMC 6.288 as it relates to used boat dealers. Used boat dealers will be exempted only if they sell used boats exclusively. The exemption does not include dealers that sell used boat parts, because the RCW does not require boat dealers to track used boat parts. This exemption is not unique in that, the proposed used boat dealer exemption mirrors the exemption provided to used automobile dealers in SMC 6.288.030 when the used automobile dealer holds a valid Washington State license pursuant to RCW 46.70.

The fiscal impact of this exemption is a reduction of approximately \$2,600 per year to the General Fund revenue. This number is based upon the elimination of an estimated twenty licenses issued per year to used boats dealers, at \$130 per license.

**Summary of the Legislation:** Amends the Seattle Municipal Code to exempt used boat dealers from the used goods regulatory licenses imposed by the city and provides for a refund of any such licenses paid for the years 1999 and 2000.

**Background:** This legislation results from the request of used boat dealers to be treated under the city's regulations in manner similar to used auto dealers in the city.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subsection 6.288.020(B) of the Seattle Municipal Code and Ordinance 109416, §1 (part), as amended, is further amended as follows:

### 6.288.030 LICENSE REQUIRED -- EXCEPTIONS

B. The provisions do not apply and a license is not required.

\*\*\*

1. To engage in business as a used vessel dealer, if holding a valid Washington State Registration issued pursuant to Chapter 8802 RCW, provided that the used vessel dealer does not sell used vessel parts.

Section 2. A used vessel dealer who possessed a valid Washington State Registration issued pursuant to Chapter 8802 RCW on or after January 1, 1999, may apply in writing for a refund of any used goods dealer license fee paid after January 1, 1999. The application for a refund must be received by the Director, Revenue and Consumer Affairs, no later than December 31, 1999, and must include a copy of the valid registration.

Section 3. The City Clerk is directed to publish this ordinance in the City's legal newspaper, state as part of that publication that the entire text may be examined electronically at

<http://clerk.ci.seattle.wa.us> on the Internet, or in paper form at the offices of the City Clerk, First Floor, Seattle Municipal Building, 600 Fourth Avenue, Seattle, WA 98104, or will be mailed upon request.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10) days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.
