8 A. A person is guilty of Negligent Control of an Animal if he or she has possession, custody or

10 B. "Negligence" includes, but is not limited to, failure to comply with or violation of any provision
11 of Section 9.25.083 or Section 9.25.084.

12 C. Negligent Control of an Animal is a gross misdemeanor.

14 **Section 2.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its
15 approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10) days after
16 presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the criminal code, adding a section to Chapter 12A.06 of the Seattle Municipal Code.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 12A.06 of the Seattle Municipal Code (Ordinance 102843, as amended) is further amended by adding the following section:

12A.06.060 Negligent Control of an Animal.

A. A person is guilty of Negligent Control of an Animal in the First Degree if he or she has possession, custody or control of an animal that, because of the person's negligence, inflicts bodily injury on another person.

B. A person is guilty of Negligent Control of an Animal in the Second Degree if he or she has possession, custody or control of an animal that, because of the person's negligence, places another person in reasonable fear of bodily injury.

C. "Negligence" includes, but is not limited to, failure to comply with or violation of any provision of Section 9.25.083 or Section 9.25.084.

D. Negligent Control of an Animal in the First Degree is a gross misdemeanor. Negligent Control of an Animal in the Second Degree is a misdemeanor.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its

approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10) days after
1 presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.



B. "Negligence" includes, but is not limited to, failure to comply with or violation of any provision of Section 9.25.083 or Section 9.25.084.

C. Negligent Control of an Animal is a gross misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10) days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.
