ORDINANCE 120843

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Street and Sidewalk Use Code, amending SMC 15.17.050.

WHEREAS, errors in the description of the No Vending Zone were discovered after passage of Street Vending legislation; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to correct these errors to protect the health safety and welfare of the public and stadium event attendees around Safeco Field during Safeco Field Events;

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. SMC 15.17.050 is amended as follows:

SMC 15.17.050 No vending zone.

It is unlawful to sell, offer to sell, solicit orders, rent, lease, or otherwise peddle any goods or services in a public place within the area bounded by the ~~((south margin))~~ center line of South Royal Brougham Way, the ~~((east margin))~~ center line of First Avenue South, the ~~((north margin))~~ center line of South Atlantic Street and the west margin of Third Avenue South for the day (a twenty-four hour period from midnight to midnight) of any event scheduled at Safeco Field.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10) days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.

Dear Council President Steinbrueck:

I am transmitting the attached ordinance for Council consideration.

This ordinance corrects language in C.B. 114160 intended to provide a "no vending zone" on the public areas and sidewalks adjacent to Safeco Field during stadium events. Due to an overlooked mistake, the street margins specified in C.B. 114160 erroneously excluded the sidewalk areas, instead identifying what is equivalent to the Safeco Field property lines. This ordinance defines and provides for the "no vending zone" that was originally intended.




