AN ORDINANCE amending Seattle Municipal Code 15.17.010 Section B. relating to areas where mobile vending is restricted.

• **Summary of the Legislation:**

This ordinance amends the area where mobile vending is restricted related to proximity to public schools. It restricts mobile vending to within one thousand feet (1000 feet) of any public school. The prior restriction was to within two hundred feet (200 feet) of any public school.

• **Background:** The purpose of this legislation is to extend the zone around public schools that mobile vending is restricted.



ORDINANCE 115253

AN ORDINANCE amending Seattle Municipal Code Section 15.17.010 Section B relating to areas where mobile vending is restricted.

WHEREAS childhood obesity which has tripled over the past 30 years has led to significant increases in the early onset of traditionally adult diseases and conditions such as Type 2 diabetes, high blood pressure, high cholesterol, sleep apnea and joint pain; and

WHEREAS Seattle Public Schools have been making a concerted effort to provide nutritious meals in their high school cafeterias and mobile vending removes students from the school lunchroom and typically provides less nutritious meals; and

WHEREAS there have been numerous problems with illegal street vendors attempting to sell food to high school students during the school day; and

WHEREAS the Seattle School Board supports the effort to expand the prohibition of street vending from 200 feet of public schools to 1000 feet;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Seattle Municipal Code 15.17.010, last amended by Ordinance 121242, is amended as follows:

15.17.010 Areas where mobile vending is restricted....

B. Within two hundred (200) feet of any public park, as defined in the Park Code, Ordinance 106615 as amended (Seattle Municipal Code Chapter 18.12), or within ~~two hundred (200) feet~~ one thousand (1,000) feet of any public school.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10) days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.
