**ORDINANCE** 121868

AN ORDINANCE appropriating money to pay certain audited claims and ordering the Payment thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Payment of the sum of Ten Million, Four Hundred Eighty One Thousand, Eight Hundred Thirty Eight and 63/100 dollars (\$10,481,838.63) on Summit mechanical warrants numbered, 4000963303- 4000965292 plus manual or cancellation issues for claims, plus Electronic Financial Transactions (EFT) of Eight Million, Four Hundred Twenty One Thousand, Eighty Eight and 82/100 dollars (\$8,421,088.82) are presented for ratification by the City Council per Chapter 42.23 RCW.

SECTION 2. That any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance, being an ordinance required for the payment of salaries or current expenses shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the City Charter.




