ORDINANCE 121906

AN ORDINANCE appropriating money to pay certain audited claims and ordering the payment thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1. Payment of the sum of Eleven Million, Four Hundred Eight Thousand, Two Hundred Fifty Seven and 17/100 dollars (\$11,408,257.17) on Summit mechanical warrants numbered, 4000976385- 4000978970, plus manual or cancellation issues for claims, and Electronic Financial Transactions (EFT) in the amount of Ten Million, Five Hundred Thousand, Four Hundred Ninety Nine and 74/100 dollars, (\$10,500,499.74) are presented for ratification by the City Council per Chapter 42.23RCW.

SECTION 2. Payment of the sum of Twenty Six Million, Three Hundred Eighty Thousand, Five Hundred Thirty Six and 12/100 dollars (\$26,380,536.12) on City General Salary Fund mechanical warrants numbered 50895739 – 50897773 plus manual warrants, agencies warrants, and direct deposits numbered 330001 – 339798 representing Gross Payrolls for payroll ending date Aug. 9, 2005 as detailed in the Payroll Summary Report for claims against the City which were audited by the Auditing Committee and reported by said committee to the City Council on Aug.18, 2005 consistent with appropriations heretofore made for such purpose from the appropriate Funds, is hereby approved.


SECTION 3. That any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance, being an ordinance required for the payment of salaries or current expenses shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the City Charter.


