ORDINANCE 123333

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Seattle-King County Taxicab Advisory Commission; amending Section 3.73.030 of the Seattle Municipal Code to correct an error in the number of commissioners appointed by Seattle, and clarifying the method by which commissioners are to be appointed.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 3.73.030 of the Seattle Municipal Code, which section was created by Ordinance 123131, is hereby amended as follows:

3.73.030 The Commission - Appointment and Term

All positions are numbered one through eleven. Individuals shall be appointed into each of the numbered positions. Members in odd numbered positions from position one to position nine shall be appointed by Seattle. Individuals in even numbered positions from position two to position ten shall be appointed by King County. Of Seattle's (~~four~~) five appointed positions, (~~two (2)~~) three (3) shall be appointed by resolution of the City Council and two (2) shall be appointed by the Executive. King County shall determine the method by which they shall appoint their positions. Position eleven shall be appointed by the Commission itself. For the initial round of appointments the positions will be staggered: positions one, two and five shall serve one-year terms, positions three, four, nine, and ten shall serve two-year terms, and positions six, seven, eight, and eleven shall serve three-year terms. At the conclusion of the initial term of each appointment, all subsequent terms of each position shall be for three years and the term of 1/3 of the positions shall expire each year. A commission member whose term has expired shall continue to hold office until a successor has been appointed by the appropriate



1 body. No members shall serve more than two consecutive terms. Any vacancy for an unexpired
2 term shall be filled in the same manner as for an original appointment under this section.

3 Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days from and after its
4 approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after
5 presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.

Legislation Title:

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Seattle-King County Taxicab Advisory Commission; amending Section 3.73.030 of the Seattle Municipal Code to correct an error in the number of commissioners appointed by Seattle, and clarifying the method of by which commissioners are to be appointed.

• **Summary of the Legislation:**

The Council generated legislation makes minor amendments to Section 3.73.030 of the Seattle Municipal Code to correct a drafting error created under the original enabling legislation that created this commission (Ordinance 123131). The amendments clarify that appointments to this joint commission made by the City of Seattle are done so by resolution and indicates that the correct number of appointments by Seattle is five members, not four as was listed in the original ordinance.

Ordinance 123131 created the Seattle King County Taxicab Advisory Commission. This commission was created in response to new rules adopted by both Seattle and King County governing the joint licensing of taxicabs. The commission will advise elected officials and departments in both jurisdictions.


