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4 AN ORDINANCE appropriating money to pay certain audited claims and ordering the

6 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:**

7 Section 1. Payment of the sum of \$23,526,190.43 on Summit mechanical warrants  
8 numbered 4002386134 – 4002389246 plus manual or cancellation issues for claims, E-  
9 Payables of \$215,946.46 on Summit 9000017325– 9000017416 and Electronic Financial  
10 Transactions (EFT) in the amount of \$42,920,562.74 are presented for ratification by the City  
11 Council per Chapter RCW 42.24.180.

12 Section 2. Payment of the sum of \$39,393,281.56 on City General Salary Fund  
13 mechanical warrants numbered 51215374 – 51216327 plus manual warrants, agencies  
14 warrants, and direct deposits numbered 360001 –371710 representing Gross Payrolls for  
15 payroll ending date Aug. 26 , 2014 as detailed in the Payroll Summary Report for claims  
16 against the City which were audited by the Auditing Committee and reported by said  
17 committee to the City Council Sept. 4, 2014 consistent with appropriations heretofore made  
18 for such purpose from the appropriate Funds, is hereby approved.

19 Section 3. That any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of  
20 this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

21 Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its approval  
22 by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after  
23 presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.



### ORDINANCE NO. 124566

AN ORDINANCE relating to land use and zoning, establishing minimum floor area ratio requirements for lots with pedestrian designations within Urban Centers, Urban Villages, and the Station Area Overlay District; for lots in the Northgate Overlay District on a Major Pedestrian Street, and for lots zoned Seattle Mixed abutting a Class 1 or Class 2 Pedestrian Street within a Station Area Overlay District; amending Sections 23.47A.013 and 23.48.009 of the Seattle Municipal Code.

AN ORDINANCE relating to centralized City human resources services;

changing the name of the Personnel Department to the Seattle Department of Human Resources and affirming the department's organizational role in City government; amending various sections of Chapters 3.02, 3.122, 3.124, 4.04, 4.08, 4.10, 4.13, 4.14, 4.20, 4.21, 4.24, 4.26, 4.28, 4.30, 4.33, 4.34, 4.36, 4.40, 4.44, 4.50, 4.70, 4.77, 4.78, 4.79, 4.86, 4.88, 4.94, 4.100, 5.08, 5.33, 6.78, and 10.02 of the Seattle Municipal Code to change references associated with the Personnel Department and the Personnel Director to the Seattle Department of Human Resources and the Seattle Human Resources Director, respectively; repealing obsolete Section 4.04.190 of the Seattle Municipal Code; uncodifying Section 4.04.270 of the Seattle Municipal Code; and making additional provisions for enacting this ordinance.
