6 **21.49.052 - Small general service (Schedules SMC, SMT, SMS, SMH, SMB, and SMD)**

7 A. Small general service is general service provided to customers who are not demand metered
8 or, if demand metered, have had in the previous calendar year more than half of their normal
9 billings at less than 50 kW of maximum demand. Classification of new customers as small
10 general service customers will be based on the Department's estimate of maximum demand in
11 the current year. Customers who are assigned flat rate bills shall be charged according to Small
12 general service rates.
