ORDINANCE 97240

AN ORDINANCE making a reimbursable appropriation from the Emergency Fund to the Seattle Design Commission Operating Fund and declaring the emergency therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That as requested by the Mayor in C.F. 261919 the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) is hereby appropriated from the Emergency Fund to the Seattle Design Commission Operating Fund established by Ordinance 96897 as a loan to be repaid within ninety days of the effective date of this Ordinance from funds allocated to pay the costs incurred for the services of the Seattle Design Commission in connection with Capital Improvement Projects referred to said Commission and the City Comptroller is authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrants and make the necessary transfers.

Section 2. WHEREAS, the appropriation herein made is to meet actual necessary expenditures of the City for which no appropriation has been made due to causes which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of making the 1968 Budget; Now, Therefore, in accordance with Ch. 7, Section 8, Laws of Washington 1967, Regular Session, by reason of the facts above stated and the emergency which is hereby declared to exist, this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon the approval or signing of the same by the Mayor or passage over his veto, as provided by the Charter of the City.

That as requested by the Mayor in C.F. 261919 the sum of Forty-five Thousand Dollars (\$45,000) is hereby appropriated from the Emergency Fund to the Seattle Design Commission Operating Fund established by Ordinance 96897 as a loan to be repaid from funds allocated to pay the costs incurred for the services of the Seattle Design Commission in connection with Capital Improvement Projects referred to said Commission and the City Comptroller is authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrants and make the necessary transfers.

Section 2.
