ORDINANCE 99422

AN ORDINANCE relating to sick leave for certain city officers and employees and amending Section 1 of Ordinance 88522 to authorize sick leave for certain purposes during pregnancy.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance 88522 as last amended by Ordinance 96867, is further amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That as of July 1, 1968, cumulative sick leave with pay computed at the rate of .046 hours for each hour on regular pay status as shown on the payroll, but not to exceed forty (40) hours a week, and all the benefits of this ordinance shall be granted to all city officers and employees in the classified civil service over whom the legislative authority has jurisdiction in this respect; provided, members of the Police and Fire Departments under State Statutory Pension Systems and those employees specifically excluded by provisions of salary ordinances shall not be included and no sick leave shall be granted or allowed on account of pregnancy except for regular medical examinations required during pregnancy and while such officer or employee is on regular pay status as shown on the payroll. Officers and employees shall be credited with the number of hours indicated by the balances of their respective sick leave account as of the effective date of this amendment. Employees entering City service on and after January 1, 1961 shall not be entitled to sick leave with pay during the first six months of employment but shall accumulate sick leave credits during such six month period.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section.....2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.


