ORDINANCE 09998

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the issuance of permits by the Superintendent of Parks and Recreation for the use of tennis courts on park property for professional tennis instruction and fixing fees therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Superintendent of Parks and Recreation is hereby authorized to issue permits for the use of tennis courts on park property for professional tennis instruction subject to reasonable conditions specified therein, including but not limited to times and places for instruction and fees to be charged therefor, and to charge and collect in connection with the issuance of each such permit a fee which shall be equal to ten percent of the gross receipts of fees charged for instruction carried on in accordance with such permit.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 2... This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.



BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:


