WHEREAS, the Seattle City Council is willing and able to comply with the provisions of Initiative 276:


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEATTLE THAT

The Seattle City Council reaffirms its support of Initiative 276 and pledges to comply with the provisions of Initiative 276: and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT
