RESOLUTION 30853

A RESOLUTION establishing a special committee of the Seattle City Council to review and make recommendations relating to possible Council-proposed amendments to the City Charter to be submitted to the voters on November 7, 2006.

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Seattle was adopted at the general election of March 12, 1946; has been amended numerous times; and was last amended at the general election of November 5, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wants to review possible amendments to the City Charter, and may decide to submit one or more proposed amendments to the voters of Seattle on November 7, 2006; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the subject of proposing possible Charter amendments warrants creation of a City Council special committee dedicated to this single issue; NOW, THEREFORE,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEATTLE THAT:**

Section 1. The Seattle City Council hereby establishes a special committee on Charter Amendments. This special committee shall be comprised of Council President Nick Licata and Councilmembers Richard McIver and Peter Steinbrueck, and shall be chaired by Councilmember Peter Steinbrueck. A quorum for convening a meeting of this special committee, or for taking committee action, shall be one named member of the special committee. Any Councilmember may participate on any topic of interest within the Charter Amendment special committee's purview, and when present, any Councilmember may vote on a proposed committee recommendation to the Full Council.

Section 2. The scope of the Charter Amendment special committee shall include reviewing and making recommendations relating to possible Council-proposed amendments to the City Charter to be submitted to the voters on November 7, 2006. If the Charter Amendment




1 special committee recommends that the Council propose Charter amendments to the voters, the  
2 special committee shall review and recommend to the Full Council one or more resolution(s) to  
3 submit such proposition(s) to the voters.

4 Section 3. The Charter Amendment special committee shall prepare and implement a  
5 community involvement action plan. That plan should include providing information to the  
6 Seattle community about, and establishing opportunities to comment on, the subjects of any  
7 Council-proposed Charter amendments. This public input process should occur prior to adoption  
8 of any resolution or ordinance submitting any Council-proposed Charter amendment  
9 propositions(s) to the voters.

11 Section 4. The Charter Amendments special committee shall cease to exist no later than  
12 November 7, 2006, unless extended by future action of the Council or the Council President.


