WHEREAS, between 1998 and 2005, a number of Council Bills, Resolutions, and Clerk Files were not acted upon by Committees; and,



NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEATTLE:


That the Council Bills, Resolutions and Clerk Files listed on Attachment A be declared retired from referral to Full Council and/or Committee assignment.


