5 WHEREAS, the City of Seattle is fortunate to be home to many outstanding artists and  
6 arts organizations that enrich our quality of life, including Speight Jenkins, who  
7 fostered Seattle Opera's legacy of excellence for 31 years; and

8 WHEREAS, Seattle Opera celebrates its fiftieth anniversary as a highly respected  
9 professional opera company recognized for its international reputation of  
10 excellence and its significant contributions to our region's culture and economy;  
and

11 WHEREAS, Speight Jenkins produced 1,227 performances of 92 operas as General  
12 Director of the Seattle Opera; hosted live broadcasts on Classical KING FM radio  
13 of every production since 1989; and has advanced the art form by bringing opera-  
14 goers from all over the world to attend his renowned productions of Ring of the  
Nibelung, Orpheus and Eurydice, Tristan and Isolde, Parsifal, and many others;  
and

15 WHEREAS, gifted with the ability to hear the potential in a young singer, Speight  
16 Jenkins has played an important role in developing the artistry and careers of  
17 many of today's greatest opera singers, nurturing talent through Seattle Opera's  
Young Artists Program and the International Wagner Competition; and

18 WHEREAS, Speight Jenkin's work has been celebrated by a National Endowment for the  
19 Arts Opera Honors Award, an Entertainment Design Magazine EDDY award, a  
20 Wagner Society of New York Anton Seidl Award, and a Seattle Mayor's Arts  
Award; and Speight has been declared one of the 25 "most powerful" names in  
21 American opera by Opera News and one of the 55 most influential people in the  
Seattle music scene by Sound Magazine; and

22 WHEREAS, after years of devotion to Seattle Opera and to advancing opera as a  
23 welcoming art form for all, the City of Seattle proclaimed Speight Jenkin's last  
24 day as General Director on August 9, 2014, to be "Speight Jenkins Day;" NOW


1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEATTLE, THE**  
2 **MAYOR CONCURRING, THAT:**

3 Section 1. The portion of 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue North between Mercer Street and  
4 Republican Street shall have an honorary designation as "Speight Jenkins Way."


5 Section 2. The Council requests that the Seattle Department of Transportation

**Summary of the Legislation:** This legislation requests the Seattle Department of Transportation to manufacture, install, and maintain memorial signs at prominent and appropriate locations out of existing departmental budget for the honorary naming designation of "Speight Jenkins Way" for 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue North from Mercer Street to Republican Street.

**Background:** Speight Jenkins has been the General Director of Seattle Opera for 31 years, making it one of the most respected opera companies in the world. His devotion to advancing opera as a welcoming art form for all, combined with his award-winning productions, has been an outstanding contribution to the City of Seattle. The short non-arterial road to be designated in his honor is near Seattle Opera's performance center.
