Budget Action description:

This green sheet would add \$33,000 GSF to the Seattle Office for Civil Rights (SOCR) to:

- restore \$28,000 in funds for consultant and professional services proposed to be cut in the Mayor's budget; and
- add \$5,000 to continue City sponsorship of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Day celebrations.

The restored consultant funding would be used to pay for activities that extend the City's Race and Social Justice Initiative (RSJI) efforts beyond City government and into the broader community. The restored funds would support the RSJI Community Roundtable, the RSJI Summit, the Seattle Race Conference, the RSJI Speaker Series and other community events, provision of educational materials, and support for external technical assistance.

Funding for the Seattle Center's annual Martin Luther King Jr. Day event is proposed to be cut in the 2012 budget. This green sheet would add \$5,000 to SOCR's consultant budget so that the City can partner with other organizations and continue to sponsor an event on Martin Luther King Jr. Day.
