The gift includes a cash gift of \$11,880 to fund the installation of the bicycle counter and display totem. The installation is estimated to cost \$11,880. The gift also includes an in-kind donation of the bicycle counter, display totem and web site, valued at \$22,120 for a total gift of \$34,000.
