


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

A \$5 million dollar, five-story, 66,000 sf major renovation of this 1890 building. Complete new shell and core, mechanical and electrical systems, seismic retrofit, new windows, masonry restoration and new elevator.
- Monique Lofts  
Renovation of an 85-year-old building into 26 artist-style condominiums. 56,000 SF, \$3.6 Million replacement of building systems.
- On the Boards Theatre  
Complete replacement of all the typical theatre functions of the old ACT theatre. 35,000 SF, \$1.2 Million upgrade of lighting, acoustics, concessions, etc.
