

- Research Study Coordination of Rapid HIV testing devices to determine which give more accurate and timely identification of early HIV infection. This involves provision of rapid HIV testing for MSM at the Harborview STD Clinic, recruitment of study participants, coordination of study sites at Gay City and the Primary Infection Clinic, and compilation and dissemination of study progress to community stakeholders.
- 2006 – 2011 **Seattle University Communication Department - Seattle, Washington**
- Administration Assistant to the Communication Studies department staff, faculty, and students, where my responsibilities included administrative duties for the department such as supporting faculty on projects planning, assisting students with university policy and student needs, and representing the department at university functions. This involved me in advising and assisting students, scheduling appointments with faculty and advisors, coping with problems and unexpected situations and taking responsibility for the department budget, reimbursements, web content management, data management of student records and faculty evaluations, accounts payable and receivable, supervision and training of work study student assistants.
- 2004 – Present **Seattle/King County Public Health Department - Seattle, Washington**
- Disease Intervention Specialist, where my responsibilities included working with populations at high risk for HIV/STIs in commercial sex venues. This involved me in interviewing clients with skills obtained through Motivational Interviewing trainings, testing high-risk clients for HIV/STIs through rapid tests, blood draws, and specimen collection, as well as providing test results and counseling clients on how to reduce risk, manage diagnoses, and providing information on relevant topics. In this position I have directly delivered HIV/STI tests and pre/post test counseling to over 300 MSM of diverse backgrounds, ages, ethnicities, and gender identities.

2003 - 2006 **Lifelong AIDS Alliance - Seattle, Washington**
Program Coordination in various areas, including the men's prevention program, special volunteer groups, and the executive team. This involved me in leading programs, creating educational materials, coordinating events, overseeing annual budget reviews, assisting the executive director and board of directors on logistics for projects and events such as AIDS Lobby Day, educational conferences, and volunteer coordination.

2000 - 2003 **Nebraska AIDS Project - Omaha, Nebraska**
Program Coordination in various areas, including the state-wide men's prevention program, the programing targeted to transgender/transsexual recently incarcerated commercial sex workers, and the Statewide AIDS Hotline. This involved me in leading programs, creating educational materials, facilitating recurring state-wide workshops based on a holistic health approach for gay, bi, and transgender populations, coordinating projects and events, overseeing annual budget reviews, and volunteer coordination. Additionally, this position entailed tracking program participants, extrapolating quantitative findings, reporting findings to the state department of human services.
