

<p>Appointment</p> <p>I attended the University of Wisconsin Steven's Point (UWSP) where I obtained a Bachelor of Science in Sociology in 1999. My last semester at UWSP was spent in the South Pacific attending classes in Fiji, Australia and New Zealand. I moved to Seattle afterward to teach Environmental Education at YMCA Camp Orkila on Orcas Island. Camp Orkila was the crowning of 6 years employment with the YMCA that included Wisconsin and Colorado teaching environmental education, pre-school and directing summer camps. In 2000, I moved to Seattle and started my professional career. I continued working in the non-profit sector, the most significant employment period was with the Environmental Careers Organization (ECO). ECO trained the next generation of environmental professionals by offering paid internships for recent college students, working with federal agencies like the Bureau of Land Management and National Park Service. ECO's Diversity Initiative was of particular interest to me, I became an annual speaker at national conferences promoting diverse students to consider the environmental sector for their careers.</p> <p>Caila works for Lifelong AIDS Alliance as a HIV Case Manager. She volunteers with Out In Front, a LGBT Leadership Program, which with she is working on program development and implementation. Her prior work experience includes work at the LGBT Center at the University of Pennsylvania and volunteer and intern experience with the Alzheimer's Association.</p> <p>Caila graduated from the School of Social Policy and Practice at the University of Pennsylvania in 2009 with a Master's Degree in Social Work and previously attended Syracuse University where she studied Social Work and Psychology as an Undergraduate. Caila grew up on the East Coast in a small town North of Boston and currently resides in the Ravenna neighborhood.
