



### 2. Items Requiring Council Action/Approval

### 3. International Special Review Board

Rebecca Frestedt briefed the Council about the ISRB elections scheduled for November 16, extended an invitation to submit nominees for consideration, and left some printed materials for distribution.

### 4. Streetcar Overview

Ethan Melone presented an overview of the concepts pertaining to the upcoming streetcar project, and advised the Council that SDOT would be inviting a group of stakeholders in the ID to discuss the impact to the community.

### 5. Committee Reports

- a. Finance Committee – Mike Omura introduced Ms. Vern Wood, the new Director of Finance and asked her to brief the Council about the financial reports.
- b. Real Estate - Paul Mar reported that the Committee did not meet. His briefing included an update regarding the Cafeteria Modernization project, the Atlas Hotel, and the 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue block. He also reported on the Capital needs assessment for PDA owned properties IDVS 1 and IDVS 2.
- c. Senior Services – Josephine Tamayo Murray reported Legacy House is moving along, that operations of the Legacy House is good. She also mentioned that Tommy Tomlinson had anticipated budget cuts and built her budget accordingly but hopes she'll be able to made adjustments if the funding for Senior Services programs is not too deep.

- d. Council Development – Josephine Tamayo Murray reported that based upon follow-up with two candidates who had been interviewed for the Council, the next step would be to affirm their election to the Council.

- g. IDEA Space Advisory – Joyce Pisanont's report included an update of Public Safety and other activities the staff have been involved with.

She reported the ID had received press coverage lately on several topics and referred to copies of the articles included in the Council packet.
