

- 7-year terms
  - The Mayor
  - The Chair of the *City Council's Public Safety and Education Committee* or its successor with respect to education issues
  - The Superintendent of the Seattle School District
  - A representative of the Seattle School Board
- 3-year terms
  - 3 citizens (1 appointed by the Mayor and 2 appointed by the City Council)
- 2-year terms (*initial term only*)
  - 3 citizens (2 appointed by the Mayor and 1 appointed by the City Council)
- 1-year terms (*initial term only*)
  - 2 citizens (1 appointed by the Mayor and 1 appointed by the City Council)
