**Subject** **Mayoral Appointments to Seattle Freight Advisory Board**

The Seattle Freight Advisory Board is charged with advising the City Council, the Mayor, and all departments and offices of the city on the development of a functional and efficient freight system, and on all matters related to freight and the impact that actions by the city may have upon the freight environment. The Board was established in 2010 and is to be composed of twelve members. Because this is a newly formed board, the terms of the appointees vary. They carry with them the possibility of renewal for one additional two-year term.

I am happy to forward to the City Council the following appointments to the Seattle Freight Advisory Board.

The appointment bios are as follows:

**Linda Anderson**

Ms. Anderson is an Executive Board Officer of Amalgamated Transit Union Local 587 and a Metro bus driver. She has been involved for many years in transportation policy in Seattle and is actively involved in the Alaskan Way Viaduct replacement project. As a Metro bus driver, she has driven nearly all of Seattle's arterials in a large vehicle and combines this practical perspective of a professional driver with a comprehensive understanding of transportation planning issues.

**Alon Bassok**

Mr. Bassok is a Freight and Economic Analyst with the Puget Sound Regional Council (PSRC). He has graduate degrees in Urban Design and Planning from the University of Washington, where he also serves as an Affiliate Assistant Professor in the sustainable transportation certificate program. He has published numerous refereed journal articles, book chapters and reports on freight, transportation and urban planning topics.

**Anne Goodchild**

Ms. Goodchild is an assistant professor at the University of Washington's Department of Environmental and Civil Engineering. Prior to her academic career, she was a manager at PricewaterhouseCoopers, LLP in London, England. She has published numerous articles on freight and logistics topics and serves on several Transportation Research Board committees related to freight topics. She is also the Associate Director of the Freight Operations Research Program at Transportation Northwest.

**Bob Viggers**

Mr. Viggers is the General Manager for Charlie's Produce, where he has worked for 24 years. He serves on the Viaduct project's North Portal working group and has a strong interest in transportation issues, including freight. Charlie's Produce is full service produce company, supplying restaurants, grocery stores, institutions, wholesalers and the marine industry with a full range of conventional, organic and specialty produce and floral. Charlie's is a locally owned, private company and is the largest independently owned produce company in the Pacific Northwest.
