


Barton Pump Station: Existing & Proposed Footprint



Have interpretive signage with clean, clear designs using easily legible fonts that reference technology;


Introduce the facility to the public and instruct how the facility works to fulfill the Division's mission.

Types of information conveyed will include:


- History of site (year pump station was built, who owns it, and its function);





Park Bench
