***Budget Action description:***

C.B. 117626 would authorize the Director of FAS to: transfer 198 City-owned vehicles to King County; retain the agreed-upon compensation; and refund the unspent portion of the capital reserves the County paid for vehicle maintenance and replacement.

For many years, the City has managed Public Health’s fleet. As compensation, the City collected lease payments that include a maintenance component and a vehicle replacement component. In 2011, the County asked the City to place a moratorium on replacing its Public Health vehicles as a budget measure, and earlier in 2012 notified the City of its intent to assume full responsibility for the entire Public Health fleet. The proposed Bill will transfer to the County 198 vehicles and an estimated \$1.46 million in cash from the capital reserve. The City would retain approximately \$562,032 as compensation for the transferred vehicles.
